

### How Do I Know?

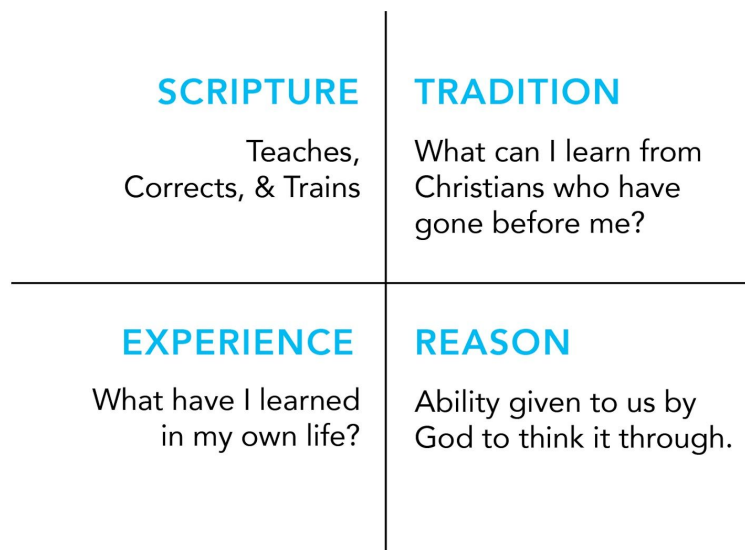
