GROUP DISCUSSION

1. What new insights did you gain from Rebekah’s explanation of what Outreach is?
2. What ways are you already doing “outreach” at Cokesbury or in your community?
How would you describe your motivation for doing outreach?

3. Matthew 22:37-39 challenges us to love our neighbor. How can you live out this scripture this week?

4. Another word for “disciple” is follower. If people will come to know and love Jesus by the way we live, how does your life show that you love and follow Jesus? In what ways do you want to take a next step?

5. Rebekah posed two questions to help anyone who is trying to determine where to do outreach: What lights your fire? What breaks your heart? How would you answer these questions?

6. In thinking about what lights your fire and breaks your heart, how might you take Next Steps to serve in those areas?
