GROUP DISCUSSION

4. Corporate/Communal/Group worship provides an opportunity for us to be encouraged, challenged, supported, and held accountable. How have you experienced any of these aspects or others in this type of worship?

5. Personal worship is when you are by yourself to pray and think. What have your personal worship experiences been like?

6. Anna challenged us to find ways to engage in Corporate worship, including inviting someone to attend with you. She also challenged us to engage in Personal worship by setting aside time and space to give God our full attention. And for us to pray everyday that God would help us live our lives as a sacrifice to God, that our whole lives would be an act of worship so that other people would come to know the same grace, love, and forgiveness that we have found in Jesus.
